1. Thank the Lord! The Mandarin version of the Kairos MP3 player," Gospel On The Go - Walking with Jesus" series has completed its update and will begin distribution at the end of the month. Kairos has recently released an electronic version of "Three-in-One Biblical Study Series of Pauline Epistles", which combines the audio, video and text material plus study guides for teaching into one electronic file stored in USB drives or SD cards for easier carry. 3. The compilation of the "Three-in-One Biblical Study Series of the Major Prophets" will be completed soon. Please pray for us to find an appropriate publisher in the mission field to publish this biblical training material.

4. Thank you for your prayers that we have completed the recording of the Cantonese version of the Audio Bible Study Books of Nahum and Habakkuk and they will be ready for distribution at the end of May.

5. Good News! No registration is required when you enter the website of Kairos Institute to study any courses available and that the Audio Bible study Book of Daniel will be added to the website soon.

6. The replacement work of the roof of our headquarters has started this month. Please pray for the work to be done smoothly and on schedule. The initial estimate of the cost was \$50,000, but after further reviews the cost was doubled because of the severity of damage due to aging. We want to thank one more time all brothers and sisters who have given financial support to us on this project. For the funds we still need, we continue to trust the Lord for His timely provision.
