In the mundane world there are good fathers and bad ones, or rich dads and poor ones. In the Bible there are praiseworthy fathers and unworthy one. Take King David as an example. Among the 19 sons mentioned in the Bible, first son Amnon raped his half-sister Yamar. Her brother Absalom, David's third son, killed Amnon. King David did not handle these family crimes. Absalom and King David's fourth son Adonijah tried without success to dethrone their father. Would a good and praiseworthy father raise such bad sons?

There are many good fathers described in the Bible, too. The much-tormented Job is an example. The Bible recorded Job's seven sons and three daughters as this: "His sons used to go and hold a feast in the house of each one on his day, and they would send and invite their three sisters to eat and drink with them. When the days of feasting had completed their cycle, Job would send and consecrate them, rising up early in the morning and offering burnt offerings according to the number of them all; for Job said, "Perhaps my sons have sinned and cursed God in their hearts." Thus Job did continually."(Job 1:4-5, NASB) A God-fearing man himself, Job had always wished that his children did not sin, nor forsook God. He made arrangements for them to be purified and sacrificed a burnt offering for each of them. I would like to have such a good father!

May God doubly bless all hard-working fathers and help those bad fathers to repent and return to righteousness.
