

God's faithfulness is also evident in the grace He has bestowed upon us in the past. In the past year, Kairos has experienced numerous blessings. Despite the challenges posed by the pandemic, we successfully held the physical Kairos 36th-anniversary Thanksgiving Banquet in early October, with separate sessions conducted in Mandarin and Cantonese. Despite capacity limitations due to the pandemic, everyone joyfully gathered together. Throughout the year, we continuously released new video series and lectures in Mandarin, Cantonese, and English, covering various categories such as biblical study, spiritual devotion, counseling, prayer, hymns, interviews, and special lectures on faith and practice. Additionally, through the "Kairos Media" YouTube channel, we provided a platform for churches, evangelical organizations, and theological institutions to exchange resources. Praise the Lord! In the past year, the Kairos Media channel has garnered 819,062 views. If we consider the past two years since its inception, the total viewership has reached 1,203,813, with 7,220 subscribers.

Although our service in China has been hindered due to the pandemic, we have maintained our connection with the churches and pastors there and increased our intercessory prayers for one another. We have also provided necessary resources through the "Wisdom Hear Clear" WeChat public account, which serves Chinese pastors and Christians. The number of subscribers has exceeded 4,000, with over one million views in the past two years.

In 2022, we will continue to uphold the founding declaration of Kairos: faithfully fulfilling the Great Commission proclaimed by our Lord Jesus, diligently serving as a multimedia platform for studying, listening to, and reading Bible materials, humbly extending our arms as an extension of the global church and disseminating the truths of the Gospel. This year, we aim to expand our service to various churches and missionary organizations. In addition to providing a platform for evangelism and ministry exchange, we are also eager to share the media hardware equipment and resources that God has blessed Kairos with. We welcome collaboration and contact from interested parties. Regarding our program offerings, we will continue producing new video series and lectures. In January, we aired new series in Mandarin, including "Who is He?" and "A Ray of Sunshine," as well as the Cantonese series on "Zechariah" from the "Bible Sounds Good" program and the second series of "Exploring Chinese Characters." Furthermore, we will enhance the content of the "Kairos e-Learning" platform, with a recent addition being the "New Testament Commentary" section.

We express our heartfelt gratitude to the churches, pastors, and brothers and sisters who have continuously supported and prayed for Kairos. May the Lord remember and reward you, and may He guard your peace. Let us together rely on our faithful Lord and walk united on the "Path of Hope" He has given us.
